BERRIA newspaper was created in 2003, after the closing of Euskaldunon Egunkaria. It was created to cover the need for information in the Basque language. Nowadays it is the only newspaper published in Basque. The closing of Egunkaria provoked a lot of protest, and many actions were organized to start up another Basque-language newspaper. Basque society contributed 4,595,900 _ (24.404 shares) to get a national Basque-language newspaper (as Egunkaria was).

It is published six days a week and has a daily circulation of 21,000 issues.
