

Nya Åland was started in 1981 as a cooperative movement, and as a result of a conflict between the staff and the board of the established newspaper on Åland (tidningen Åland).

Nya Åland was first published twice weekly, but is now published five times a week. We have been a morning paper since 1995. After many years of financial instability, the company now has a solid structure. The newspaper is now owned by the former co-op members, as well as two major owners, the foundation Konstsamfundet and Wiklöf Holding.

Nya Åland is most importantly a local newspaper for the people on the Åland Islands. We have no political or religious affiliations.

We try to make a newspaper that serves as our readers' voice and also mirrors the society we live in.
